

What is Canstruction?

Canstruction is an international hunger-relief competition where teams compete to design and build giant structures made entirely out of full cans of food.

How Will Canstruction of the Southern Tier Benefit Broome County?

All of the proceeds from Canstruction of the Southern Tier will help support hunger-relief activities in Broome County. The donated food will be distributed through CHOW to hunger-relief agencies in Broome County including food pantries, soup kitchens, and community meal programs. The funds raised will be donated to the Food Bank of the Southern Tier and earmarked for hunger-relief activities in Broome County.
